Participants improve their strategic leadership skills to achieve agency missions, drive performance, and align short-term action with long-term direction. The program features a 4 ½ day Live Online workshop, and provides leaders with skills to handle complexity, bridge boundaries and shape organization culture for success.

Deadlines

Students must enroll no less than 8 ½ weeks prior to Workshop start date in order to allow time for the required pre-work.

For private group training, Funding Documents and Final Participant Roster must also be received no less than 8 ½ weeks prior to desired Workshop date to begin Program and guarantee Workshop start date.

Online Facilitator

A CCL certified instructor with experience in the federal workplace facilitates hands-on experiential activities, small group activities and discussions, and polls. Students also meet 1:1 with a coach, ensuring their attention and engagement throughout the course.

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Leading Strategically in the Federal Government

Leading Strategically in the Federal Government’s Program spans 17 weeks and features several components that occur prior to the live Workshop session. Pay special attention to the timeline, noting the Registration deadline, Program Start, Workshop, and any Coaching sessions.

High Level Program Timeline

Registration DEADLINE	8 ½ Weeks before Workshop Start Date	Registration deadline is set this far in advance due to the amount of time normally required for Participants to complete assigned pre-work.
Program Begins	Launch	This is the start date of the overall LSFG Program. There are no meetings or live session on this day.
 Pre-work launches in CLA	Week 1	This is the date Participants may access the program materials via the CCL Leadership Accelerator Learning Platform (CLA). Participants will receive an email with a link to the portal, and their access credentials. There are no meetings as part of this pre-work phase, and pre-work will be asynchronously completed by the Participant.
Pre-work Due	Week 6	This is the date that all Participant pre-work is to be completed (asynchronously). There are no meetings on this day.
Coaching Session #1	Week 7-8	One week before the Workshop Start, there will be a 60-minute coaching session between the Participant and the Coach to establish the Coach/Coachee relationship. Coach will contact the Participant 2 weeks prior via email to schedule the Session date and time.
WORKSHOP	Week 9	This is the 4 ½ day live online Workshop. See the Workshop Agenda on page 3 for more information.
LSFG Post-Program content available	Week 10	Participants may access LSFG Post-Program asynchronous content and activities (via CLA) starting the Monday after the Workshop concludes.
Coaching Session #2	Weeks 10-11	This is a 90-minute, one-on-one Feedback Coaching call between the Participant and Coach. It is to be conducted 1-2 weeks after Workshop (date is flexible based on participant’s availability).
Coaching Session #3	Week 13	This is a 60-minute one-on-one Coaching call between the Participant and Coach (1 of 2 sessions) one to three months after the Workshop (date is flexible based on participant’s availability).
Coaching Session #4	Week 17	This is a 60-minute one-on-one Coaching call between the Participant and Coach (2 of 2 sessions) one to three months after the Workshop (date is flexible based on participant’s availability).
LSFG Post-Program content end date	6 Months from End	LSFG materials will be available for six months. This is the last date for Participants to access the LSFG Post-Program content and activities.

Critical Note! For private group training, Funding Documents and Final Participant Roster must be received by this date to begin Program and guarantee Workshop start date. This is due to the amount of time normally required for Participants to complete assigned pre-work.



Live Online

This is a pre-scheduled session with Participant and Coach (online/virtually), and the exact date may be scheduled to accommodate Participant’s availability.



Asynchronous

Important activities to be completed by the Participants alone. Not a live, virtual or face-to-face activity.



Live Online

This is a scheduled session that Participants must attend (online/virtually).



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Workshop Agenda

Additionally, you will complete 2 self-assessments that will help you focus on your leadership development priorities right now.
